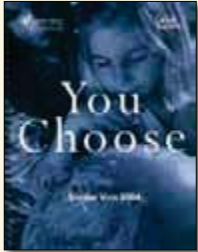


Roots of Equality

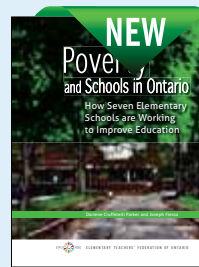
More Than A Play – \$5

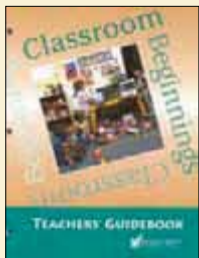
The Heart and Art of Teaching and Learning: Practical Ideas and Resources for Beginning Teachers – \$20
