# ETFO BURSARIES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

**The Scholarships and Bursaries Program offers financial incentives on an annual basis to members, children and non-members entering faculties of education, members studying at the graduate level and members upgrading their qualifications at publicly funded universities/institutions.**

## DESIGNATED FOR WOMEN ONLY

### **Bursaries for Designated Groups (Open to non-members)**

Up to eight bursaries of up to \$625 to female members of designated groups who are entering a faculty of education at a publicly funded university/institution or ETFO female members of designated groups who are taking a qualification/upgrading course at a publicly funded university/institution.

\*Not intended to support a master's or doctorate program.

### **Doctoral Scholarship**

This scholarship may be offered to active female members to study at the doctoral level at a publicly funded university/institution. One award of \$2,500 may be granted.

### **First Nations, Métis and Inuit Scholarship (Open to non-members)**

Up to two scholarships of \$12,500 for FNMI women who are entering their first year of a full-time undergraduate degree program at either Brock University or Lakehead University. \*Not intended to support a master's or doctorate program.

### **First Nations, Métis and Inuit Women in Education Bursary (Open to non-members)**

Up to four bursaries of up to \$1,250 for FNMI women who are entering a publicly funded faculty of education or ETFO FNMI women members who are taking a qualification/upgrading course from a publicly funded university/institution. \*Not intended to support a master's or doctorate program.

### **New! Learning and Leadership Bursary**

Up to three bursaries of \$750 to an active female member who is pursuing professional learning and leadership opportunities through an additional qualification course from a publicly funded university/institution, a professional learning leadership course or attending a leadership workshop/conference.

### **Master's Scholarship**

Up to four awards of \$1,250 to active female members to study at the graduate level at a publicly funded university/institution.

### **Bachelor of Education Bursaries for Sons and Daughters**

Up to 12 bursaries of \$500 to be granted to a daughter or son of an active member entering a Bachelor of Education program in a faculty of education at a publicly funded university/institution.

### **Bursaries for Members of Designated Groups (Open to non-members)**

Up to eight bursaries of up to \$625 offered to members of designated groups entering a faculty of education at a publicly funded university/institution or ETFO members of designated groups who are taking a qualification/upgrading course at a publicly funded university/institution. \*Not intended to support a master's or doctorate program.

### **Doctoral Scholarship**

One award of \$2,500 to study at the doctoral level at a publicly funded university/institution.

### **ETFO Member Bursaries**

Up to eight bursaries of up to \$625 for members who are entering a faculty of education or who are taking a qualification/upgrading course at a publicly funded university/institution. \*Not intended to support a master's or doctorate program.

### **New! First Nations, Métis and Inuit (FNMI) Professional Learning Bursary**

Two bursaries of \$750 to an active member taking a FNMI-focused additional qualification course from a publicly funded university/institution, a FNMI professional learning course or attending a FNMI workshop/conference.

### **Master's Scholarship**

Up to four awards of \$1,250 to active members to study at the graduate level at a publicly funded university/institution.
