



FACULTY OF EDUCATION AWARD APPLICATION

CRITERIA

The Faculty of Education Award is offered annually to a student at a Faculty or School of Education at a publicly-funded university/institution in Ontario, during the final year of their teacher training. Up to 17 awards of \$500 and a certificate of recognition may be granted. This award is not intended to support a master's or doctorate program.

Candidates for the **Faculty of Education Award** will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:

- a) The recipient is enrolled full-time in an Ontario faculty of education and registered in a Bachelor of Education or credentialing program (e.g. OISE/UT Master of Teaching) primary/junior or junior/intermediate program, participating in the final year of teacher training;
- b) The recipient demonstrates a commitment to social justice and equity in keeping with ETFO policy;
- c) The recipient demonstrates exemplary teaching practices in practicum placements;
- d) The recipient demonstrates initiative to broaden personal experience in educational culture. Some possible indicators of this include, but are not limited to:
 - Leadership in student government at faculty of education
 - Support for fellow teacher candidates
 - Provincial/local ETFO involvement;
 - Leadership in events which benefit fellow teacher candidates; or
 - Exemplary interactions with students in a variety of educational settings.
- e) The recipient demonstrates academic excellence in bachelor of education courses.
- f) The recipient is recommended by both the practicum supervisor and an associate teacher, in writing, outlining how in their opinion, the candidate meets the above criteria. Written recommendations to be included with application.

Preference given to applicants who have NOT received an ETFO award, scholarship or bursary previously.

PROCEDURES

1. Complete the application form. ETFO must receive your application by February 1, 2022. Completed applications may be emailed as an attachment to awards@etfo.org or mailed to: **ETFO Awards Committee, 136 Isabella St, Toronto ON M4Y 0B5.**

2. The ETFO Awards Committee reviews applications and recommends candidates to the ETFO Executive for final decision. You can expect to hear regarding the disposition of the award after **June 1, 2022.**
3. Please ensure that confirmation of acceptance, which can be an **Offer of Admission** or **Letter of Acceptance** from your attending institution or **Proof of Payment** into the Bachelor of Education or credentialing program is included with your application.



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4. Applicants may only apply for one ETFO award in any given year. Applying in more than one category will result in disqualification.
5. Materials submitted to the Awards Committee in support of an application become the property of the Awards Committee.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The recipient must be in the final year of the Bachelor of Education or credentialing (e.g. OISE/UT Master of Teaching) program, and study period must occur between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022.
