Applicants should demonstrate:

- Active membership within ETFO and strong understanding of ETFO priorities;
- Varied/extensive experiences as a classroom teacher (e.g., occasional teachers, coaches, consultants, lead teachers, associate teachers, mentors);
- Clear ability to embed equity within ongoing instruction and assessment practice through an anti-oppressive framework;
- Experience in teaching diverse student populations and partnering with their families;
- Value and modelling of professional judgement and collaborative professionalism;
- An openness to integrate feedback and suggestions through the revision process;
- Engaging writing for an educator audience; and
- Strong technology skills.

APPLICATION PACKAGE

ETFO members must submit:

- A complete application form;
- A one-page cover letter outlining how you meet all of the criteria for the position;
- A current résumé (maximum two pages);
- Two letters of reference, highlighting your relevant skills, and expertise; and
- A writing sample illustrating your deep understanding and commitment to equity and social justice related to a recent teaching experience (maximum one page).

- Be sure to include your full name on all supporting documents.
- Late or incomplete application packages will not be accepted.
- Deadline for application and supporting documents is **June 24, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. (EDT)**

- Receive a payment for blog contributions.
